THE NATION'S QUEST

Prince Henry Will Arrive in America February 22.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 15.—Dr. von Holleben, the German Ambassador at Washington, today received a cablegram from Berlin giving the dates of arrival and departure of Prince Henry and a list of the party who will accompany him to the United States. Prince Henry will arrive on the Kronprinz Wilhelm, February 22, and will sail for Germany on the Hamburg-American liner Columbia, March 3. He will be accompanied by Hofmarschal Vice-Admiral von Seckendorff and two Aids-de-Camp, Lieutenant-Commanders Schmidt von Schwin and Von Erdly. His chief physician will be Dr. Reich, Herr von Tirpitz, the German Secretary of State for the Navy, with his Aid-de-Camp, Lieutenant-Commander von Trotha, will also accompany the Emperor's son. Emperor William will send the Adjutant-General, Von Plessen, Captain of the Navy von Muller and von Grune, Aid-de-Camp to the Emperor. Prince Henry will have his own retinue of about 200 men, and each of the gentlemen of the party will bring his own valet. Herr Hintz, the chief clerk of the Secretary of State for the Navy, will be one of the party.

WILL LAND AT NEWPORT NEWS

He Will Be Accompanied by a Number of Distinguished German Officers—Plans for His Reception.
