FIVE NEW SUBSTATIONS

IMPORTANT INCREASE IN PORTLAND POSTOFFICE FACILITIES.

Stamps Will Be Sold and Money Orders Issued—Congestion Will Be Relieved.

The crowded condition of things at the postoffice, where people often have to stand in line awaiting their turns to buy postal supplies or secure money orders, has caused Postmaster Crossman to make application for the establishment of substations in this city. He has just received instructions to establish five such substations here, with facilities for the transaction of money order and registry business, and for the sale of stamps and other postal supplies. These substations will be located as follows:

No. 1—235 Gibbs street.
 No. 2—Thirteenth and Jefferson streets.
 No. 3—Fourth and Washington streets.
 No. 4—135 Seventeenth street, North.
 No. 5—Corner Twenty-third and Saylor streets.

When these substations are opened, the congestion at the postoffice will be relieved, in some measure at least. It will be understood that no mail is sent to these stations, which are expressly for the sale of stamps, issuance of money orders, and for registering letters.

The postmaster is not yet ready to announce the date when the substations will be ready for business.

CONTRACT SOON TO BE LET

Great Labor in Connection With

Widening Whitehouse Road.

The contract for widening the White House road from 40 to 80 feet will be let by the Board of County Commissioners as soon as it has been prepared by Judge Calk, and after certain unsettled matters in connection with the work have been disposed of. For example, the specifications provide for drain pipes to be placed four feet under the ground. Roadmaster Steele expressed an opinion that drain pipes at such depth will not accomplish anything, and the board decided to obtain some expert advice on the subject, and the drain pipes will not be put down so deep if the experts advise to the contrary.

The Commissioners also decided that the contractor must agree to roll the road very hard before the rock is placed upon it and an eight-ton roller belonging to the county will be loaned to the contractor if he does not have one of his own.

Chief Deputy County Clerk Gambell figured out the bids and announced the following figures:

Smyth & Howard, \$14,500, including \$500 for moving buildings and fences.

S. W. Aldrich, \$16,814, including \$1100 for moving buildings and fences.

Lind & Manning, \$19,120.

Pacific Coast Construction Company, \$24,000.

J. R. O'Neil, \$21,972.

The last three did not bid on the moving of fences and buildings.

The work bid upon was as follows:

Excavating solid rock, 1000 cubic yards; excavating earth, 25,000 yards; concrete, 150 cubic yards; vitrified pipe, 8 inches 800 feet, 12 inches 300 feet, 18 inches 225 feet, and 24 inches 200 feet; tiling, 46 inches 22,000 feet, 6 inches 3000 feet. Also cleaning and grubbing four acres. The work was bid on at 20 cents per cubic yard, etc., and to find the lowest bidder (Smyth & Howard) it was necessary to make calculations of the total of each item.

TEAMSTERS MAKE DEMAND

They Want Higher Wages, and Give Employers Until May 1.

Members of the local chapter, No. 162, of the Teamdrivers' International Union, want higher wages. At the last meeting of the union it was decided that the present scale is too low, and it was agreed to ask for an increase of 25 cents per day for each and every driver. Accordingly, the leading transfer companies have been notified that after May 1 the individual wages of teamsters must be \$2.50, instead of \$2.25.

The teamsters say that the country is prosperous and that the increase in rent and cost of living fully justifies their demand. They do not wish to be understood as unreasonable in the matter, for they
