State of Washington Exhibit Is Assured.

\$10,000 NOW READY FOR USE

Convention of Chambers of Commerce at Olympia Receives \$5000

Offers From Two Men Until They Raise Money.

OLYMPIA, Wash., April 25.—The convention of Chambers of Commerce at Olympia today, to discuss an exhibit at St. Louis in 1903, resulted in the assurance that the State of Washington will be represented at the Louisiana Purchase Exposition.

First—That the different commercial bodies of Washington raise and expend the sum of \$10,000 for preliminary work.

Second—That after this sum is secured, Governor McBride be requested to appoint a commission consisting of J. H. Stuebel, chairman, to be selected from business men in different portions of the state, who shall serve without compensation, other than actual necessary expenses.
