BEF TRUST ENJOINED

Restraint Order Issued by New York Supreme Court. ALBANY, N. Y., June 4.—Supreme Court Justice Chester today granted an injunction restraining certain beef-packing companies of the West from carrying on business in this state in violation of the Donnelly anti-trust law. The order was served on the representatives of the concern in this city and Troy today, and will be served on others throughout the state as quickly as they can be reached. It was obtained on the affidavit of D. W. Meredith, ex-manager of Swift & Co. The injunction is directed against Armour & Co., Swift & Co., Cudahy Packing Company, Hammond Company, Schwartzchild & Sulzberger Co., domestic and foreign corporations, and against Nelson Morris, Edward Morris and Ira N. Morris, copartners, carrying on business as Nelson Morris & Co. Their managers and all persons acting for them are restrained and enjoined from fixing and determining by combining together the prices to be charged for meat, and from agreeing among themselves as to the supply of meat to be brought into this state by them, and from acting upon any understanding or agreement to do so. The injunction also enjoins them from fixing or determining the prices of their and each other's products by agreement. They are also enjoined from acting under an agreement to do so. The price of labor shall be affected or competition therein affected, and also from maintaining uniform rules for credit to dealers or fixing uniform prices for cartage.
