

BIG DROP IN CORN

Now There Is Talk of an End-of-July Corner.

ENTIRE CROWD STOPS TO SELL

Generous Supply Moving East Probably the Cause of Slump—Wheat Opens Firm, but Declines Steadily Throughout the Day.

It is believed the July corner in corn will be dealt a hard blow today by the Chicago Board of Trade, which will set on the market a "marginal price" for the cereal. A slump of 5/8 cents was recorded yesterday.

CHICAGO, July 14.—A heavy movement in corn held the attention of grain speculators today, and brought slumps all round. July corn continued to display pyrotechnics of late week, although today it looked like the falling, which instead of the rocket's flight.
