

NO EXPANSION YET

Magnates Fail to Agree on Change in Circuit

LUCAS RE-ELECTED PRESIDENT

His Salary and Bond Increased—McIntyre Suspended From the League—Forfeited Guarantee Increased—Star Chamber Session.

SPOKANE, Oct. 15.—(Special.)—

The magnates of the Pacific Northwest Baseball League met here today in their annual meeting. W. H. Lucas was re-elected president for the third term; no agreement could be made on the matter of expansion of the circuit, so it was dropped; the forfeited guarantee was raised from \$500 to \$1000; the president's salary was raised to \$2000; and his bond as treasurer to \$10,000; President Lucas was sent to the annual meeting of the National Association of Professional Baseball Clubs, and Third Baseman McIntyre, of the Butte team, was suspended from the league.

There will be no expansion of the Pacific Northwest Baseball League next season. At the annual meeting of the league, held at Spokane Hotel, this afternoon, applications for franchises were made by Vancouver, B. C., and Victoria, B. C., Great Falls, Mont., and Salt Lake City, Utah. An application from Ogden was expected, as was also a representative of that town, but neither appeared. W. B. Weaver, of Salt Lake, was the only personal representative of outside cities. He said he had \$1000 to post as a forfeit guarantee to cover membership.

After a lengthy discussion, with Portland, Helena and Tacoma pulling against expansion, and Seattle, Spokane and Butte working for the move, it was apparent that no majority vote could be secured, and the expansion matter was dropped.

The directors of the league met first in the early afternoon. Representatives were: Helena, E. J. Goodkind; Butte, C. C. Lane; Spokane, Harry Green; Tacoma, Stuart Rice; Seattle, D. E. Dugdale; and Portland, J. P. Marshall.

Reports of the secretary and treasurer were read, and Messrs. Rice and Lane were appointed an auditing committee. It was decided to raise the forfeit guarantee from \$500 to \$1000. The pennant for 1902 was formally awarded to Butte.

Lucas Re-elected President.

The annual meeting of the league convened after the directors adjourned. P. Marshall, of Portland, was made chairman. After action on proposals for membership, President Lucas was re-elected president, and Harry Green, of Tacoma, was elected secretary. The following directors were chosen: E. J. Goodkind, Spokane; C. C. Lane, Butte; J. P. Marshall, Portland; D. E. Dugdale, Seattle; John S. Baker, Tacoma, and J. P. Marshall, Portland.

It was decided to send President Lucas to the annual meeting of the National Association of Professional Baseball Clubs, at New York, October 23, where he will represent the Pacific Northwest League. The president was empowered to secure three first-class tickets for himself and his family for the next season. The amount of bond of the league treasurer was increased to \$10,000 from \$5000. After the meeting a dinner was given to the league officials by Harry Green. Plans for next season were informally discussed.

McIntyre Suspended From League.

Third Baseman McIntyre, of the Butte team, will no longer play ball in the Pacific Northwest League. He was suspended by the directors this afternoon for improper conduct during games at Portland. The matter was supposed to be kept a secret, but it leaked out after the annual meeting. The action came as a general surprise, as most of the fans had almost forgotten the incident at Portland, when McIntyre made himself obnoxious to the spectators and more so to President Lucas. No other players were disciplined, and the general sentiment was that Lucas had been very lenient with the season's offenders.

No Charges Against McCloskey.

No charges were made against McCloskey, despite the reports current for several days that such action would be taken. All the Spokane players and others with whom he was said to have had dealings here were waiting in the lobby of the hotel while the meeting was in progress, and McCloskey says there were plenty of witnesses to prove the falsity of any charges which might be presented.

When Lucas Goes to the National Meeting.

When Lucas goes to the National meeting at New York October 23, he will ask permission for the Pacific Northwest League to raise salary limit from \$2000 per month to at least \$2500 per month. The vote on this proposition was unanimous, so it is reported, all the representatives expressing the opinion that it would be difficult to get the material wanted for next season's teams if the limit was left at the present figure.

President Lucas said:

"The raising of the guarantee from \$500 to \$1000 is the best evidence of the tenor of the meeting. It was the prevailing sentiment that the league was in good condition and sure to be a winner again next season. The raising of the guarantee shows the faith the men interested, and will serve notice on the baseball world that this league is a strong one and well able to make its promises good."

The league meeting was a star chamber affair.

President Lucas and the rest of the members are solemnly bound by resolution not to divulge anything except the official statement.

Secretary Marshall, of the Portland club,

when asked for a statement this afternoon, told The Oregonian correspondent he was pledged not to divulge any of the proceedings.
