

WHEAT GOES HIGHER

Market Advancing Under Demand From Australia.

AN ORDER RECEIVED FOR CLUB

Crop Prospects in Argentina and Elsewhere—Review of the Past Week in Local Markets—Other Market News.

When continued inquiry from Australia the wheat market is slowly but steadily climbing. Prices are firm at the moment, club being worth 70c and bluestem 82c for exporting purposes.

Crop reports from Argentina continue favorable, and the export surplus is expected to amount to at least 1,000,000 bushels and possibly 1,500,000 bushels.

In nearly all parts of Europe, with the exception of portions of Russia, the crops are wintering well and give satisfactory promise.

When the weather report shows winter wheat to be in fine condition, although growing somewhat too rapidly under the fine weather.

Hops are slower after a period of activity following the opening of the new year. The sales lately made show that full values are being maintained.

THIS YEAR'S TOMATO PACK. Total Output of 9,828,812 Cases Was the Largest on Record.

New York Times. The 23d annual report of the tomato pack of the United States and Canada estimates the total output as the largest on record and more than double the short crop of 1921.

The pack by states was led by Maryland, which turned out 4,314,382 cases of two dozen cans each, followed by Indiana, with an output of 992,606 cases.
