EACH WILL GO IT ALONE

ALLIES NOT GOING INTO JOINT CONFERENCE WITH BOWEN.

Claims Against Venezuela to Be Adjusted Separately—Britain and Italy Will Raise Blockade.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 19.—Minister Bowen's arrival in Charleston tomorrow, it is understood that the representatives of Great Britain and Italy do not feel it incumbent upon them to wait the coming of Baron Speck von Sternberg to the point being made that they are not interested in the claims of each other or of Germany.

It has been agreed that the claims of private citizens for injuries suffered in Venezuela shall first be adjusted. These claims will not be decided until Minister Bowen's arrival, as the representatives of the powers have been instructed that the first move along this line is to ascertain the claims of the powers.
