SHIPMENTS OF GOLD

STOCKS DEPRESSED BY THE EXPORTING MOVEMENT.

Cotton Speculation Making Demands on the Money Market—Nearly All Stocks Close Lower.

NEW YORK, May 15.—There was a very considerable liquidation in the stock market today. The selling seemed induced by a crystallization of sentiment which has been approaching definite formation for some time, but has been deferring action in the stock market in the hope of a recovery. There was no development to cause the decline except an engagement of \$2,250,000 of gold for export to Europe. This had been quite definitely extended and the amount was rather less than some of the forecasts. There was a slight holding in the gold loan rate in response to the gold movement, but it could not be said that any liquidation was forced by the withdrawal of credit over Sunday.
