

GRAIN FOR 'FRISCO

Steamer South Portland Sails With Full Cargo.

Many Heavy Shipments Sent Oregon Wheat Needed as Stiffening for California Barley Shipments.

The steamer South Portland sailed for San Francisco yesterday with a full cargo of wheat, oats and millfeed.

Another factor that is contributing to the urgency of the demand for wheat in San Francisco is the dispatching of a number of barley ships.

Local exporters do not look for much activity in shipping here until the San Francisco market settles down to an export basis.
