SPokane Wash., Oct. 15.—(Special)—This county is to be one of the battle grounds between the McBride and the anti-McBride factions in the Republican

Representative J. B. Lindsley, a warm adherent of Governor McBride, is mentioned for Lieutenant-Governor, and also for Congress. It is felt that the McBride people should bring a fight on Congressman Jones.

Senator Herman D. Crow, a Wilson man with McBride leanings, is a candidate for Supreme Judge. The fight here may develop into a fight between Lindsley and Crow on one side, supported by the McBride people, and Sanders and Shaw on the other side, supported by the anti-McBride people.

Mr. Lindsley, who is the most likely candidate of the McBride people, is strong locally, and would put up a hard fight. He would not only have the solid McBride backing locally, but he has Senator Wilson under great obligation to him, and could command the support of the remnants of the Wilson machine, as well as a considerable support from local business men.

The opposition to McBride is handicapped in another quarter. It is bitter enmities within its own ranks. Marshall Hopkins is an ancient enemy of Colonel W. M. Ridpath, E. D. Sanders and a number of leading Ankeny men.

Another thing in McBride's favor is his aggressive support of the Spokane Spokesman-Review, the leading daily paper of Eastern Washington, which, while independent in politics, has always wielded a strong influence in behalf of any political cause.
