Big Steamship to Load Wheat and Flour.

COMING FROM SAN FRANCISCO

Big Fleet of Coasters Brought Up by the Southwest—French Bark May Return to Australia In Ballast.

The steamship Lytton, a 500-ton carrier, has been chartered to load flour and wheat at Portland for the Orient. The identity of her charterers has not yet been disclosed, but it is probable that she will take some of the flour which was left behind by the two big liners which the Portland & Asiatic Steamship Company dispatched a few days ago.

ASTORIA, Or., Nov. 8.—(Special.)—There was a small mutiny this morning aboard the American schooner Joseph Russ, which is lying in the lower harbor laden for San Francisco. The vessel expected to go to sea this morning, but the crew who composed her crew refused duty. Captain Garski came to this city, and secured four other men, but when these were taken aboard the original crew would not leave the vessel.

DUNS LAW IN PORT.

This is an increase of 76 vessels of 254,148 tons gross register and of 151,388 tons net register during 1902.
