tion in the county. The new mills of smaller capacity contribute to the local trade, and in many of these there has been an increase of capacity.

The year has witnessed the erection of several expensive homes in Corvallis, as well as in other towns. In spite of the erection of 40 or 50 new dwellings in Corvallis last year, and the fact that the Summer is every month full and there is demand for more, a fact eloquent of the growth and progress of the community.

There has been in the business of the Corvallis creamery, and in the business of the Corvallis sawmill increases in the capacity and facilities of the Corvallis creamery, and the Corvallis Sawmill has hived materially to the aggregate of local business. It is doubtful if the county has ever seen in a like manner a larger balance on the right side of the ledger than is consequent from the operations of the past 12 months.
