

SUPPLY BILLS FIRST

Senate Managers Will Try to Shut Out Other Business.

WOOD'S CASE MAY COME UP

Foraker Will Lead the Contest in Favor of Confirmation as Major-General - Philippine Shipping Bill May Be Considered.

WASHINGTON, March 6.—The plans of the Senate managers to keep the supply bills to the front to the exclusion of other business, consideration of the naval bill will be resumed tomorrow and then the army appropriation bill will be taken up. It is expected that by the time the army bill shall have been disposed of, the bill making appropriation for fortifications or that providing funds for the District of Columbia will be ready. An effort will be made to secure consideration of the nomination of Brigadier-General Leonard Wood to be a Major-General during the week, and if time is found for executive sessions this matter will be given precedence. Senator Foraker will have charge of the contest in favor of the confirmation and Senators Scott and Blackburn of the opposition.

If the appropriation bill and the Wood case do not consume the entire time, Senator Lodge's Philippine shipping bill will be further considered. Senator Beveridge will make another attempt Thursday next to pass a number of pending Alaskan bills.

Postoffice Affairs in the House.
WASHINGTON, March 6.—Postoffice affairs will occupy the attention of the House for the better part of this week. Overstreet, chairman of the committee on postoffices and post roads, will call up the postoffice appropriation bill tomorrow and it is anticipated several days at least will be consumed in its disposition. The minority will vigorously oppose some features of the bill, and will also urge a general investigation of postoffice affairs.

The bill will be laid aside temporarily Tuesday, by special agreement, to consider private claim bills, which gave way last week to the Indian appropriation bill. There have been made the special order for that day. Limit the Use of Carriages.
WASHINGTON, March 6.—The conference agreement on the legislative, executive and judiciary appropriation bill measures the total carried in that measure \$2,858,832.

The conferees agreed on appropriations declaring that no money appropriated in the bill should be available to pay any persons in the public service incapacitated permanently from performing service, and limiting the use of carriages at Government expense to those used by the President, his secretary and heads of executive departments in the District of Columbia.

A NEW CHINESE NEWSPAPER.

Tong Chew, a Brilliant Yokohama Scholar, Will Be New York Editor.

Tong Chew, a young Chinaman, who arrived from Japan, has been recommended here to be editor-in-chief of a new Chinese newspaper, the first issue of which will appear on the Chinese New Year, February 18, next. It will be the official organ of the Chinese community in New York, and will be published in the Chinese language. The Chinese Reform Association, which aims at the revolution of the governmental methods of the present administration of the Flower Kingdom, the Chinese Reform Association, which is the largest organization in the world, has a membership of 5,000, although it is only four years old. The most important feature will be the editorial, which will be written for the purpose of propagating the tenets of the new reform movement. The editor-in-chief, Tong Chew, is only 24 years old, but is one of the best educated men in China. He is an ardent disciple of the reform movement and was at the time of his call to America a teacher in a reform college. Dai Tung Hok Hoh, modeled on Western lines of instruction and located at Yokohama. He will begin his duties as soon as the newspaper can be started.

The printing plant and press have been purchased and will, on their arrival, be set up in the new building at 530 East Broadway. Chinese paper is being ordered and will arrive here some time next month. The mechanical problem of setting up a Chinese newspaper will be appreciated when it is known that there are about 20,000 characters in the Chinese language. Of course, it is not necessary to employ all these characters in the printing of a newspaper, but at least 20,000 of them will be required, as each word is a character in itself and is not spelled out with separate letters as in the language of the West.

Prices Going Up in Asia.

During a recent tour in Asia of nearly 15 months from February, 1901, to June, 1903, in which I visited Japan, Korea, China, the Philippines, Ceylon, India, Siam and Laos, the Straits Settlements, Borneo, India, Syria and Persia.

found everywhere a deep interest in the changing economic conditions. The common people in Asia care little for politics, but the price of food and raw materials touches every man, woman and child at a sensitive point. Almost everywhere the old days of cheap living are passing away. Steamers, railways, telegraphs, newspapers, labor-saving machinery and the introduction of western ideas are slowly but surely revolutionizing the Orient. Shantung wheat, which formerly had no market beyond a radius of a few dozen miles from the wheat field, can now be shipped by railway and steamship to any part of the world, and in consequence every Chinese buyer has to pay more for it. In like manner new facilities for export have doubled, tripled, and in some cases quadrupled the price of rice in China, Siam and Japan.
