

ON SUMMER BASIS

All Kinds of Livestock Sells at Low Prices.

RECEIPTS ARE EXCESSIVE

Wheat Dealers Reduce Their Bids One Cent—Strawberries are in Over Supply—Slump in Cantaloupes.

Prices of all kinds of livestock are believed to be down to the summer basis. The decline has been noticeable for a month or two, and it has left the market in bad shape. Cattle are being received at the Portland Union Stockyards faster than they are required, and though heavy shipments are being made to the Sound cities, the local supply is still beyond the demand. At this time of year heavy receipts and falling prices are to be expected as growers rush in their stock, all trying to reach market before the buying drop comes. The same conditions prevail in the sheep and hog as in the cattle market.

Receipts at the Portland stockyards yesterday were 50 cattle, 30 hogs and 1400 goats. The following prices were quoted at the yards:

HEAVY DEALINGS IN ONTARIO & WESTERN AT NEW YORK.

Organized Movement by Party of Stockholders to Effect Dissolution of Voting Trust.

NEW YORK, June 6.—The accumulation of

Ontario & Western stock in today's stock market had more the appearance of an active speculation than anything that has occurred in stocks since the movement of Union Pacific in connection with the Northern Securities decision. The general market proved itself a market of speculation, and the Ontario & Western stock was the only one that showed any activity.

The organized movement on the part of a party of stockholders in Ontario & Western to effect the dissolution of the voting trust, by which the stock is held, is said to account for the movement today. In the meantime, the Ontario & Western stock is being sold in the market, and the price is said to be 100 cents.

Amalgamated Copper rose 1/2 when the report of the directors' meeting was made. The stock was sold at 100 cents, and the price is said to be 100 cents.
