

RECORDS AROUSE HISIRE

MR. WITTENBERG SAYS MISTAKE WAS MADE.

Denies That He Made Motion to Install Heating Plant for High School Football Team.

Questions of veracity caused a quick passage of a resolution at a meeting of the Board of Education last night. Clerk Allen was reading the minutes of previous meetings and came to that portion referring to the installing of an additional heating plant in the High School. The record read, "on motion of Mr. Wittenberg the plant was ordered installed for the use of the football team."

"How is that?" inquired Mr. Wittenberg. "I did not make such a motion. My intention was that the plant should be for the use of all the pupils, and I would like to see the minutes corrected."

Director Williams said the motion was as the record stated, and that was why he voted in the negative. Mr. Wittenberg didn't care why Mr. Williams voted against it. He knew he did not make any such motion as the record stated, and he would insist that it be corrected. Mr. Williams insisted just as strongly that he did specify "for the football team."

White with passion, Mr. Wittenberg appealed to the president of the Board, but with a woman's tact, Mrs. Liffon evaded the question. The record stands as Mr. Wittenberg had indicated it publicly announced that "the heater was put in for all pupils, and not for prizefighters and the exclusive use of the baseball team," and the incident was closed.

Miss M. J. Wingate applied to the Board for the privilege of purchasing the buildings temporarily used for the Park School as soon as the Wittenberg motion to sell them. Her proposition was referred to the committee on buildings.

Robert Krohn, who has been in charge of physical training in the city schools for nearly ten years, has applied for an increase of \$500 to \$1200 per year. There was some opposition to the request, but after it had been discussed and Director Warren had stated that Professor Krohn had to spend about \$14 per month for carfare, the increase was granted.

Miss Myrtle Moffett, who is one of the instructors in drawing, has applied for an increase of \$5 per month. Her carfare bill is also heavy.

Miss Esther Wiest was ordered employed as assistant in drawing at a salary of \$65 per month.
