

COLORADO FOR HIM

Roosevelt Carries the State by Over 10,000.

GOVERNORSHIP IS IN DOUBT

Peabody is Running Behind His Ticket, but Republicans Believe He is Safe—Scratched Ballots Will Decide It.

DENVER, Nov. 8.—Estimates at midnight from scattering and incomplete returns indicate a plurality of over 10,000 for Roosevelt in Colorado.

On this basis the Democrats claim that Adams is elected Governor by 7000 to 6000 plurality, with a probability that the remainder of the state ticket is also elected.

Republican Chairman Fairley said: "Colorado has gone Republican, electing by a safe majority the Electors, Congressmen and the entire state ticket."

At midnight the vote had been counted in only two precincts in Denver. In one of these were 38 scratched ballots, of which 21 were for Adams and in the other Adams had 115 out of 152.

Republicans in the Lead.

COLORADO SPRINGS, Colo., Nov. 8.—Out of 25 precincts in El Paso County on straight ballots give the Republican ticket a plurality of 1656.

Conceded to Adams.

LEADVILLE, Colo., Nov. 8.—It is conceded that Adams carries Colorado for Governor, will carry the county by possibly 400. The Republicans claim the county for Roosevelt.

Times Sure Adams Will Win.

DENVER, Nov. 8.—The Times Democrat concedes that Roosevelt carries Colorado by 6000 or 6500 plurality, and claims that Adams, Dem., will have 8000 majority over Peabody for Governor.

Post Says Peabody Has Won.

DENVER, Colo., Nov. 8.—The Post, Rep., in a late extra, says that Governor Peabody is re-elected. The Times estimates Adams' majority for Governor in Denver at 2000, and in the entire state at 7000 to 8000.

Cripple Creek Republican.

DENVER, Nov. 8.—Trilly Scott has conceded Democratic Headquarters that in all but 12 precincts of Cripple Creek there were 1843 straight Republican votes, 248 Democratic and 1610 scratched ballots.

PENNSYLVANIA.

Republicans Make Nearly a Clean Sweep—Knox Sure of Re-election.

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 8.—The Republicans made an almost clean sweep in Pennsylvania, carrying the state for Roosevelt by over 200,000, and electing two of the six State Senators and 29 of the 32 Congressmen.

Falling Off in Democratic Vote.

PHILADELPHIA, Nov. 8.—The returns counted in ten wards in Philadelphia show a falling off in Parker's vote as compared with that of Bryan of 1890, and an increase for Roosevelt over McKinley of 10,000.

INDIANA.

Republicans Have Almost, if Not Quite, Doubled 1900 Majority.

INDIANAPOLIS, Nov. 8.—Indiana has been carried by the Republicans by from 4,000 to 5,000. The Legislature will be Republican by nearly 50. All the nine Republican Congressmen are elected by increased majorities, and the Republicans claim also the Second and Twelfth Districts, but they are in doubt.

Majority at Least 50,000.

INDIANAPOLIS, Nov. 8.—At 10 o'clock Senator Beveridge, who has been watching the returns closely, said Roosevelt's plurality in Indiana would not be less than 50,000 and probably more, and that the Republican majority on joint ballot in the Legislature would be 50.

UTAH.

Roosevelt is Heartily Indorsed and Republicans Feel Sure of Governor.

SALT LAKE CITY, Nov. 8.—Scattered returns from this state indicate that Roosevelt will have a plurality exceeding 100,000. His vote shows a heavy increase in every precinct reported.

IDAHO SWEPT CLEAN

Roosevelt Carries Every County in the State.

GOODING THE NEXT GOVERNOR

Republican Plurality is Put at 23,100 for President, and About Half That Number for State Executive.

BOISE, Idaho, Nov. 8.—(Special.)—Returns from the state are so incomplete at 1:30 that it is impossible to give more than rough estimates of majorities. In every part of the state Roosevelt and Gooding ran far better than was anticipated by most observers.

There has apparently been a clean sweep in all parts of Southern Idaho and meager returns indicate like results in the North.

On the same estimate Gooding should have from 12,000 to 13,000. In some of the Mormon counties he is running ahead of the National ticket.

NEVADA.

Roosevelt Electors Win and Republican Elected to Congress.

RENO, Nev., Nov. 8.—Count proceeding very slowly. So far as heard from the Republican state ticket is in the lead and Yerington, Republican, is probably elected to Congress over Vandueh, Democrat. The state is conceded to Roosevelt.

CONNECTICUT.

Roosevelt and Republican Governor by Twenty Thousand.

NEW HAVEN, Conn., Nov. 8.—The New Haven Register, Independent, claims the right of Connecticut for Roosevelt by over 20,000. The election of Roberts, Republican, for Governor by nearly as much, and the state ticket in New Haven by 1900 to 1500.

MAINE.

Usual Republican Majorities Given in Rock-Ribbed State.

PORTLAND, Me., Nov. 8.—With a slightly decreased vote Maine today gave the usual Republican majorities. Democrats showed less interest than Republicans and many did not vote.
