What He Did for the Early Oregon Pioneers.

Victoria (B. C.) Colonist. Mr. George Himes, assistant secretary Oregon Historical Society, in a letter to the Oregonian of Portland, advocates strongly the doing of something to perpetuate the name of Dr. John McLoughlin in Oregon.

Dr. McLoughlin was the first representative of the Hudson's Bay Company on the Pacific Coast, with headquarters at Fort Vancouver, on the Columbia River, and his jurisdiction extended throughout a vast territory known as the Western department, which included practically the whole of the Pacific slope north of Mexican territory, exclusive of Alaska.
