RESTS WITH THE WOMEN. So Says Dr. Cressey Again as to Equal Suffrage. PORTLAND, Dec. 1.—(To the Editor.)—The women seem to have done me honor in re-questing their president to defend them against ideas which were never expressed nor implied in the few lines quoted from the report of my address of Sunday last in The Oregonian, a quotation which was incidental only to the general thought. Judging from the letter of your esteemed correspondent, the perturbation of mind arose not from what I said, but from imaginary implications which were read into it. A mere statement of the situation seems to have been mistaken for a statement concerning the equality of men and women. Minorities, and possibly small majorities, have thus far failed in most of the states to attain the desired end. A practically universal demand on the part of women to vote would probably, within a comparatively short period, to change in state constitutions, and that to the extension of suffrage to women. Hence, as a simple matter of fact, under the circumstances success demands this more extensive desire on the part of women in general. That such more general desire should exist and manifest itself in certain questions which rests with the women, not with the men. Whether the conditions or circumstances, however, are what they should be, whether or not the situation be just and equitable, whether or no men ought not to grant the privilege in response to the demand already existing, whether or no men are practically asking of women what they have never demanded of any class of men before granting suffrage, are questions into which I did not enter, either directly or by implication. In short, I did not discuss the justice of the situation—which I should be glad to discuss, however, at any time—should I wish the time for what seemed to me more important aspects of the general subject. "The Natural Rights of Woman." Curiously, while it was assumed by these ladies that I sought to screen the alleged minority of men's attitudes, my impression seemed to prevail among them that I am a mild but mistaken advocate of the cause.
