DIES AT THE DOCK

In far Andierne, France, there is a widow and four orphaned children this morning, for last night their husband and father lost his life in Portland harbor while attempting to escape from the ship Jules Gomet, lying at Mercer dock.

Across the continent and the broad ocean a message has been flashed to the little home in Andierne, telling of the fatal accident, but no reply has as yet been received.

Deputy Coroner Arthur L. Finley responded to a call and caused the removal of the body to his undertaking parlors, French Consul Labbe was immediately notified and will arrange for the disposition of the body.
