

EXPECT LARGE SUM

World's Fair Officials Look to Washington.

THEY DESIRE FINE SHOWING

Believe Legislators at Olympia Will Pass \$100,000 Appropriation—Other States Preparing Executive Offices to Move.

That the State of Washington will make an appropriation of \$100,000 for a representation at the Lewis and Clark Exposition is the belief of President Goode and other officials of the Exposition.

"I believe that Washington will make the \$100,000 appropriation," said President Goode yesterday afternoon. "Her interest is so closely allied to those of Oregon and she is so near the seat of the Exposition that she cannot afford to let the Exposition pass without doing her best toward showing visitors what she has done in the way of progress and advancement, commercially, socially and in every other way."

"It is my opinion that the bill authorizing \$100,000 for a representation at the Lewis and Clark Fair will not be cut. With an appropriation of this size at hand Washington can make a fine representation. She can erect a building that will be a credit to the state, can house in it building exhibits that will interest thousands of people and can entertain Washington visitors to the Exposition in a suitable and proper manner."

State Getting into Line.

As the time for the opening of the Exposition approaches the states are rushing into line rapidly. The committee will begin the erection of her pavilion, and has already prepared, shipped and unloaded a part of her display. Massachusetts will have a commissioner on the ground within a short time to begin the erection of the pavilion for that state, which will be one of the most magnificent state buildings on the grounds. Idaho and Utah have bills before their respective legislatures to increase the appropriation already decided upon. Wisconsin is making extensive preparations for her display, has a corps of men in the field gathering the material and will shortly be shipping her exhibit. Missouri is making preparations for shipping and installing her exhibit. All the states are busy preparing their displays, and soon trainloads of exhibits will be arriving at the Exposition grounds and will have to be taken from the cars and stored. The executive committee, which met yesterday afternoon, intended to appoint a manager to superintend the arriving displays, but the matter was laid aside until the next meeting. The time was spent in considering important matters not of interest to the general public.

ADVERTISES THE EXPOSITION

Northern Pacific Issues a Beautiful Booklet in Seven Colors.

MAY BE CIRCUS WAR.

Big Shows Plan to Come Here During the Exposition. There are indications of a circus war in Portland next summer during the Exposition. Ringling Bros' circus has arranged to play a week in Portland to the Exposition grounds, and Barnum & Bailey's, not to be outdone by their rivals, have arranged for a trip to the Pacific Coast, a thing they have not done for years, and will fight the Ringling people to a deadly finish. The Barnum show has a contract with the Northern Pacific Company whereby that road is under obligations not to carry any other circus over their lines during the season. It is estimated that the two shows will be in Portland almost at the same time, a circumstance which will undoubtedly cause lively competition.

Exposition Notes.

Director of Exhibits Doehs in receipt of a letter from a member of the Idaho Legislature who states that it is probable that the appropriation for the Idaho representation will be enlarged and probably doubled. It is expected that Utah will also increase her appropriation. Two more cars of exhibits arrived at the Exposition grounds yesterday. One car contained the exhibits of the State of Massachusetts and the other contained the exhibits of the Pacific Coast Rubber Company.

Work of equipping the fire department headquarters at the Exposition grounds has commenced, and workmen are busily engaged in putting in lockers, beds and other things needed to be in place by the time the firemen take up their quarters. As soon as the arrangements are completed the machines will be installed. Word has been received at Exposition headquarters that four cars of exhibits for the State of Massachusetts are on the way, having been shipped several days ago. Three cars contain a part of the educational exhibit, and the other three contain the State Building.

MAINS HAVE INCREASED

MANY ADDITIONS TO PORTLAND WATER SYSTEM.

City Water Board Hears Annual Report of Work—Director Lewis Declines Reappointment. At the meeting of the Water Board yesterday afternoon the report of Engineer D. D. Clark was read and shows a gratifying increase in mains for the year 1904. The report demonstrates that some work, particularly that on reservoir No. 4, is not as yet complete, owing to the fact that the contractor has been forced to discontinue operations on account of the weather. The laying of mains for the year is summarized as follows:

Total mains laid, all sizes, 15,579 miles; total mains relaid, larger sizes, 2,786 miles; net increase in mileage, 16,365 miles. Total length of mains now connected with the water system in the city: Distribution mains under four inches, 37,220 miles; distribution mains, four inches and over, 10,597 miles; total distribution mains, all sizes, 22,307; Bull Run conduit, 31,985 miles.

Mains in use divided as follows: West Side, 9,707 miles; East Side, 12,338 miles; Albina, 59,568 miles; total, 23,965 miles. Not included in the above are 2,457 miles of East Side, 6,736 miles of Albina, 6,890 miles.

Mr. Clark states that during the year estimates of cost were prepared for the extension of over 15 miles of mains, which amounted to \$12,000. In addition to these estimates of cost were made for about 12 miles of high-service supply mains for the Highland district, 8 inches to 24 inches in diameter, approximating \$200,000. Work on the reservoir in connection with the extension of the building of 1000 lineal feet of new drainage tunnel is cited. Of a total length of 256 lineal feet in the old tunnel, a concrete conduit, 1970 feet in length, was constructed. Contractors at work on reservoir No. 4, the report says, were forced to discontinue operations on account of bad weather, but the work will be resumed as soon as possible. Engineer Clark's report was filed in due order.

Mayor Williams expressed his willingness to reappoint L. A. Lewis to the board for another term of four years. Mr. Lewis, however, did not feel inclined to accept the reappointment for the reason that he has already served eight years in that capacity, and Mayor Williams will confer with the other members of the board in the near future to select some gentleman to fill Mr. Lewis' place.

Superintendent Dodge was directed by the board to meet with the directors of the Lewis and Clark Centennial Exposition and arrange for the World's Fair water supply. The board wishes to cooperate with the Exposition management in every way possible, so that the very best of water facilities may be had at the Fair. Mr. Dodge stated that the manager of the Inside Inn had called upon him in person yesterday morning to ascertain the manner in which he would be supplied with water. "He explained," said Mr. Dodge, "that in St. Louis the city furnished water to the Exposition management at wholesale rates and the management in turn sold the water to the concessionaires. This plan, he thought, met with the approval of all persons concerned."

The resolution of the Council to change a two-inch main on Williams avenue to a six-inch main was referred to the engineer of the Water Department. No action was taken on the recommendation of the fire committee of the Executive Board for a new lot of hydrants until Chief Campbell is conferred with.

A number of petitions for the installation of this class of hydrants are on foot. Most of them were tabled until the next meeting of the board. The request of Superintendent Dodge for an increase in pay to an employee of the department was granted. This man will in the future receive \$75 monthly instead of a per diem remuneration of \$2.00. The meeting adjourned at 5 P. M.
