

BUTTER TAKES FALL

Surprising Decline Announced by City Creameries.

MARKET DROPS FIVE CENTS

All State and Local Brands Are Affected by the Change—Lower Quotations From California Are Cause.

A sensation was caused in the butter market yesterday morning when, at the opening of business, it was announced that one of the large city creameries had made a 5-cent drop in price, lowering its quotation on extra creamery from 27 1/2 cents to 22 1/2 cents.

The decline was followed by the other local creameries and front street prices also dropped. The decline was caused by increasing receipts of cream and butter and a lower California quotation from California.
