Starting Charge Against Administrator in Zeigler-McVicker Suit.

CHICAGO, May 12.-Today during the probate proceedings begun by Dr. L. C. Zeigler to remove the alleged medical services \$120,000 from the estate of the late Mrs. Harriet G. McVicker, widow of James H. McVicker, the theatrical manager, counsel for Zeigler informed the court that an attempt would be made to show that a tin box seized by the public administrator contained, among other things, a box of letters, for the most part, payable to Dr. Zeigler, and signed by Mrs. McVicker.
