Idaho's Senator Says He Has No Quarrel With President.

WHERE THEY DO DISAGREE

In the Main, He Declares, He Is Not Opposing the Administration in Regard to Its Policy.

After all it seems that Senator W. B. Heyburn, of Idaho, is still on the Roosevelt reservation, and there is no war between Idaho's junior Senator and the President regarding forestry matters.

Senator Heyburn was here yesterday attending the Bar Association meeting and took occasion to enter some denials.

"That's all right. I don't care if I have broken with the President," said he. "While we may disagree in some matters in the main, there is nothing to warrant the statement that I am opposing the administration.

"Just what the President's forest reserve policy is to be I am not sure. I favor such protection to our forests as shall leave the land open to settlement by actual settlers. I believe in the Government's aid and assistance wherever it is necessary to protect against fires and waste of timber.

"I am opposed to the withdrawal of the Idaho forests from settlement. The settler certainly is the safest guardian of his own claim and the surrounding country against fires.
