WEATHER CONDITIONS.

A disturbance of decided character made its appearance off the Washington coast early this morning and it has advanced slowly inland. Storm southeastward were ordered displayed at the mouth of the Columbia River at 5:30 A. M. and at 8:15 A. M. a storm warning was ordered at all the remaining weather stations in this district. At 9 A. M. the North Head station reported a wind velocity of 90 miles an hour from the southeast and no report has been received from there since. The winds have not yet become severe in the Sound Country, but they have fallen in Northwest Oregon and over the greater portion of Washington.
