WEATHER CONDITIONS. The unsettled conditions noted last night developed into the most severe wind storm of the season. The following maximum wind velocities have occurred during the last 24 hours: North Head, Wash, 72 miles from the south; Seattle, Wash, 48 miles from the south; Tacoma, Wash, 40 miles from the southwest; Spokane, 40 miles from the southwest; the winds at Portland were also strong, but the maximum velocity was only 20 miles at the weather office, while at the Exposition it was 58 miles.
