FLEE WITH LITTLE BOOTY

Bartender Is Robbed of Watch and Till Is Rifled - Frightened Man Raises Alarm, but Is Not Heeded.

"Good evening, gentlemen. Kindly raise your hands and line up behind the stove." With these words, two highwaymen, their faces covered with masks, pushed open the barroom door of the Pacific Hotel, at Tenth and Quimby streets, at 7 o'clock last night. While the taller of the two covered the occupants of the room with two revolvers, compelling all to line up against the wall, the shorter robbed the money till behind the bar of \$6 and took a silver watch from V. A. Cook, the

Twelve men including two bartenders V. A. Cook and Frank Cook—and the pro-prietor of the hotel, W. H. Lehman, were in the barroom when the highwaymen entered. One of the patrons of the hotel, when the thugs entered the place, jumped from a chair near the entrance to the dining-room, and, rushing through before he could be stopped, shouted, "The place is being held up!"

One is that they sold liquor to Preston Boozer, a boy 17 years old, and the other that they per-mitted Annie Bates, 17 years old, and Stella Veal, 29 years of age, to frequent the smoon. The statute prohibits females under 21 years from entering places where intexicating liquors are sold. These cases started in the Municipal Court and are now in the hands of Robert Galloway, special prosecutor in the Juvenile Court work. The defendants were released on bail and they also furnished bonds for the appearance of the two girls as witnesses against them by order of Judge Frazer.


