Harry White and Associates Prepare to Spend \$46,000,000 to Construct 5000 Miles of Road.

LOS ANGELES, Nov. 3.—The Evening Express says: Alaska will have a railway its entire length from north to south and giving communication with the outside world.

NORTH COAST IS INDEPENDENT Director Says New Road Has Backing That Can Fight Harriman.

NORTH YAKIMA, Wash., Nov. 3.—(Special).—O. A. Fechter, one of the directors of the North Coast Railway, said today:

"The North Coast is absolutely independent of all other railways. So far there have been no steps taken to connect with any of the other systems. We are no more connected with the Chicago, Milwaukee & St. Paul than the farmers of the valley. The men of the North Coast are able to finance the route for a mile and their standing is such that neither Harriman nor the Northern Pacific can keep them from accomplishing the work if they see fit to take the route."
