

DISORDERLY PASSENGERS IN SELLWOOD

Citizens of Sellwood Protest at Insufficient Accommodations on Cars.

APPEAL TO THE COMPANY

Committee Snubbed by Management of Oregon Water Power and Railway Company and Refused Any Relief.

An emphatic and unanimous protest is going up from the residents along the Sellwood line of the Oregon Water Power & Railway Company, at the utterly inadequate street-car service furnished them by that corporation.

Overcrowded Cars. But the dissatisfaction felt by the people of Sellwood is not confined to that of those who live nearer in along the line. A portion of the passengers from Sellwood are able to secure seats each trip, but rarely if ever can the residents along the line get upon the cars which they must take to reach their work at 7:30 or 8 o'clock in the morning.

Will Promise No Relief. The most discouraging feature of the situation to the people in the southeast section of the city is that the railway company will promise them no relief, although repeatedly importuned to do so.

Has Monopoly of Traffic. The fact of the matter is that the railway company realizes that it has a monopoly of the traffic from Sellwood, and does not care how much protest is raised.

Disregard for Its Patrons. The company has shown an absolute disregard for their patrons here during the summer. It has even seen the car on a Sellwood car at the Alder-street depot, change the placard on it and send it to the Oaks.

Citizens All Protest. But the most vehement protest of all comes from the people who have to ride on the crowded cars. H. J. Thorne, who lives at Midway, said that for more than six months consecutively he did not get a seat, although his work took him into town upon every week-day morning.

Disaster-stricken with the service from the street-car company is of long standing at Sellwood. Long after the five-cent fare was in force to St. Johns, Mount Scott and other suburbs, a 10-cent fare was charged between Portland and Sellwood by this company, which then was known as the Portland City & Oregon Railway Company.
