Blizzard Follows Zephyrs in Middle West.

CHICAGO CARS TIED UP

Snow, Rain and Sleet Coat Electric Wires with Ice and Hinder the Trains—Cold Wave Sweeps Down Through Prairies.

CHICAGO, Jan. 22.—A severe storm of alternating rain, sleet and snow, which commenced just before midnight last night, caused one of the worst tie-ups this city has known in many years. But few telegraph wires were working out of the city today in any direction, there being no communication whatever with the East.

THREE HUNDRED MEN DIE

EXPLOSION DESTROYS BRAZILIAN TURRET SHIP.

Only Fifty Survive of Crew of the Aquidaban, Made Famous in Brazilian Revolution.

RIO JANEIRO, Brazil, Jan. 22.—The Brazilian turret ship Aquidaban was sunk at Fort Jacarapagu, south of Rio Janeiro, as the result of an explosion on board. It is reported that 300 of her crew perished and that only one officer was saved.

Several particulars of the accident have been received, as communication is slow. The vessel was an old-style double-turret ship, carrying a crew of 350 men and officers. She played an important part in the revolution in which Dom Pedro was overthrown.

The Aquidaban was of 400 tons' displacement and 400 horsepower. She was built in England in 1888, at a cost of \$1,725,000. She had five torpedo tubes.

Bigelow Loses a Job

NO LONGER A LECTURER AT BOSTON UNIVERSITY.

Critic of Panama Canal Conditions Does Not Give Reason of Resignation.

BOSTON, Jan. 22.—It was announced today that Poulton Bigelow, who recently criticized conditions in Panama, had resigned his position as special lecturer on international law at Boston University. The letter of resignation does not give the reason for Mr. Bigelow's resignation, but it is understood that the university officials say the resignation was not due to any action taken by them.

HOW BURTON GOT MILEAGE

Senators Convinced at Evason of Rules to Help Him.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 22.—One of the most remarkable procedures in the history of the Senate occurred today in order to avoid a technicality which prevented Senator Burton, of Kansas, from drawing his mileage for the present session. In order to have his requisition honored, it was necessary for some official of the Senate to take oath that he had seen the Senator in the Chamber, but since the indictment and conviction of the Kansas Senator, he has not appeared in the Chamber.

NEED OF GOOD SOLDIERS

President Addresses Interstate National Guard Association.

WASHINGTON, Jan. 22.—President Roosevelt spoke to the delegates to the annual meeting of the Interstate National Guard Association this afternoon at the White House. He impressed upon them the necessity of instructing their commands in target practice and original initiative as individual soldiers. He said in part:

In a great industrial civilization such as ours we may just as well face the fact that there is a constant tendency to do away with and to eliminate those qualities which make a man a good soldier. It should be the steady object of every legislator, of every executive officer and above all of you gentlemen who have to do with the National Guard, to encourage those qualities, to try to counteract the tendency toward their elimination.

Newlands Rides His Hobby.

Newlands contended that the only proper way of dealing with the combinations of railroads was through a National corporation law. Many of the state laws were loosely drawn and should be supplemented by a National law.

When Newlands concluded the Senate adopted a resolution introduced by Warren asking the use of the transport Summer in conveying the representatives of the Government to Santiago de Cuba and back on the occasion of the approaching dedication of battle monuments in the vicinity of that city.

The Senate then at 4:57 P. M. went into executive session, and at 5:05 adjourned.
