Hansbrough's Raid on Reclamation Money Wins.

DIVERTED FOR DRAINAGE

Senate Passes Bill Applying \$1,000,000 to North Dakota Swamps. Fulton's Bill Against Alien Fishermen Passes.

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Washington, Feb. 8.—To the surprise of many Senators, the Hansbrough bill setting apart \$1,000,000 out of the reclamation fund for the drainage of swamp lands in North Dakota slipped through the Senate today.

SHUT OUT ALIEN FISHERMEN

Fulton's Alaska Bill Passes, Also Others for Pacific Coast.

OREGONIAN NEWS BUREAU, Washington, Feb. 8.—The Senate today passed Senator Fulton's bill prohibiting aliens from fishing in Alaskan waters. This bill was drawn at the request of Northwest fishermen who have been injured by the encroachment of the Japanese.

Representative Humphrey today introduced a bill appropriating \$100,000 for establishing two fish hatcheries on Puget Sound.

A favorable report was made today on bills to establish a lighthouse at Cape Spencer, at the entrance of Cross Sound and at Cape Hinchinbrook, Prince William Sound, Alaska.

House Passes Bill Restoring Claims Relinquished in Error.

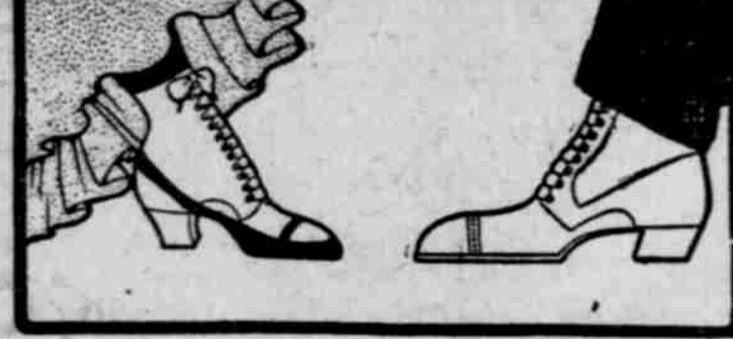
