MRS. LYDIA BUCKMAN DIES

Her Span of Life Was Nearly One Hundred Years.

Mrs. Lydia Buckman, a Portland woman, died at her home, 106 East Sixteenth street north, yesterday morning after a few days' illness, at the age of 94 years. She was born in the state of Ohio February 12, 1812, at the breaking out of the war with England, and lived through all the great events of nearly 100 years of the world's history, spending her youth on the frontiers.

She was married to Abraham Buckman February 28, 1833, and with her husband and two children moved to Marshall County, Indiana, in 1837 and settled near the banks of the Tippecanoe River, and was the first white woman to settle in what is known as Tippecanoe Township. Their nearest white neighbors were four miles away, and what roads there were through the country at that time were trails winding through forests and swamps. There was an Indian village within a little over a mile of their cabin.
