Several years ago the water consumers were asked to sign this agreement, which was to the effect that we should continue to take water from the Mount Tabor Water Company on consideration of a reduction of rates, even should another company, or somebody else, furnish water in that section, and on further consideration that we were not to be charged any more than the competing company. "I signed that agreement and I have

ADDITION TO ACCOMMODATE 150 PATIENTS IS PLANNED.

On the first floor will be offices, private rooms for women patients and dormitories. There will also be wards for the accommodation of 20 patients. There will be a padded cell in the basement for unruly patients, and six rooms in the attic for employes. A training school for nurses may be es. and six rooms in the attic for employes. A training school for nurses may be established in course of time. There will be a modern surgery department, and the new building will be lighted by electricity. There will be no final decision until the architect has prepared his plans, and the cost has been estimated.
