BAILIFF WANTS SUIT

Court Decides MacDonald Is Entitled to Salary.

MAYOR SHORN OF POWER

Appointment of Municipal Crier by the Council Legal, According to the Opinion of Judge Gantenbein.

One of the most important decisions handed down in the State Circuit Court during the summer vacation term was rendered by Judge Gantenbein yesterday.

The decision was made in the case of James MacDonald, bailiff in the Municipal Court, who sued to recover salary for the month of May.

It was held by Judge Gantenbein that the words "by law" means by statute or by ordinance, and that an appointment by ordinance is an appointment by law.

There is no restriction on the right of the Council to provide by ordinance for an appointment of this kind.

Judge Gantenbein granted a five days' stay judgment, on request of R. W. Montague and T. C. Gentry, attorneys who appeared for Mayor Lane.
