HOLDING HIS YOUNG SONS FAST BY HANDS, TEXAS MANIA WALKS TO MEET ENGINE—FATHER DEAD, BOYS WILL DIE.

TRINIDAD, Colo., Nov. 6.—(Special.)—Holding in hand of each of his two little boys, aged 7 and 9 years, respectively, and walking down the middle of the railroad track, C. A. Farham, a cotton-buyer from Chicago, deliberately walked into passenger train No. 1 last night, and not only caused his own death, but probably the death of the two children.

The train was running about 40 miles an hour when the headlight showed a man coming toward the engine leading two little boys, both bareheaded.

ALL THREE HURLED IN AIR.

All three were hurled into the air, one of the boys falling on the right side of the track and the father and the other boy on the left.
