

## GAIN OF THE PARTY

## Republican Plurality in Washington Will Reach 36,000.

## VOTE WAS VERY LIGHT

Henry McGowan, Democrat, Is Probably Elected State Senator From Pacific and Waiikikum Counties.

SEATTLE, Wash., Nov. 8.—(Special).—The Republican Congressional ticket swept Washington by a majority of approximately 36,000. Reports from every county in the state show that though the Republican control of Washington was maintained by a plurality of the same majorities as those given two years ago.

Roosevelt carried Washington by 72,822, but there were about 145,000 votes cast in that election. This year the number of votes cast is reduced nearly one-half and the Congressional pluralities of the three Republican candidates will be fully one-half of that received by President Roosevelt two years ago.

In 1904 the Congressional pluralities were 37,527, or 15,000 less than the Roosevelt margin. With a half vote cast a plurality of 29,000 would have shown the Republicans maintained their relative strength and the showing of 36,000 indicates a growth in the party vote for two years.

Reports of the election have been received from every county in the state. The tabulation of election figures in many of the counties is still incomplete and no official returns will be had until next week. The following is a close report on the Republican majorities that will be increased if any changes are made.

It is conceded by the Republican State Committee that Henry McGowan is probably elected State Senator from Pacific and Waiikikum counties.

Late this afternoon a telephone message was received from the Pacific County organization conceding the election. Nothing can be secured from Waiikikum and the state organization has decided that McGowan probably beat John W. Kleeh, Republican. Pacific also elects a Democratic state representative.

While claiming the constitutional amendments which give the right of eminent domain to loggers have carried, the lumber organizations cannot supply any figures. These figures will not be obtainable until reports from the official canvass are made to Olympia.

## LEGISLATURE IS REPUBLICAN

Chairman Brady Says Gooding Will Have Majority of 8000.

BOISE, Idaho, Nov. 8.—Chairman R. H. Brady of the Republican State Committee today issued the following statement upon the results of Tuesday's election: "We have now received sufficient returns from every county in the state to enable us to say that the Republicans will have 16 out of 21 members of the Senate and 4 out of 51 members of the House. Governor Gooding is elected by over 5000 majority and the balance of the state ticket from 15,000 to 22,000 majority."

"We have vindicated the good name of Idaho and the people have given their unqualified approval of all the things done by Governor Gooding to maintain law and order in this state. Mr. Borah will receive at least 57 votes out of 100 for United States Senator and Senator Dubois will never again attempt to ride to victory on his hobby of 'Mormonism.' "I think it is only fair to state at this time that a large majority of the leading Democrats do not now nor have approved of Dubois' course in this matter, and in the next campaign I expect to see the political battle fought on strict party lines. Idaho is normally Republican, if conditions are such, and is going to continue to be so for years to come."

It was found today that the majority in Fremont County is about 200 instead of 300. This means the "Gooding" majority about 400. The Republicans gain the Senator in Lemhi and two representatives in Kootenai, making the total 151 members of the Legislature to 21 for the Democrats. Several of the latter are in doubt.

## ALL REPUBLICANS ELECTED

Gillett, for Governor, Runs Behind His Ticket in California

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 8.—Returns from 1909 precincts out of 247 in the state give the following on Governor: Gillett, Rep., 102,172; Bell, Dem., 92,702; Langdon, Ind., 97,575. Gillett's plurality, 9,470.

The remaining precincts from remote parts of the state will not materially change the result. It is estimated that Gillett's plurality will be about 12,000.

The entire Republican State ticket is elected by pluralities slightly in excess of that for Governor. No compilation has yet been made on the Legislature, but it is overwhelmingly Republican. The entire Congressional delegation is Republican.

## Dolbeer Will Be Upheld.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 8.—Judge Coffey today rendered his decision in the Dolbeer will contest, upholding the will that left the bulk of the estate to Etta Marian Warren, the close friend and companion of Bertha Dolbeer. The contest was brought by Horatio Schander, of Sacramento, an uncle of the deceased.

Over a year ago the will was contested by Adolph Schander, another uncle, on the ground that Miss Dolbeer was of unsound mind when it was made. He received adverse decisions in both the Superior and Supreme courts, having appealed to the latter. The suit decided to void alleged insanity and undue influence. A third contest brought by the heirs of Adolph Schander on similar grounds is pending, and will be submitted to Judge Coffey for decision on the evidence taken in the previous suits.

## Langdon Polls Small Vote.

SAN FRANCISCO, Nov. 8.—The returns at midnight from 2217 precincts out of a total of 2417 give the vote on Governor as follows: Gillett, Rep., 129,904; Bell, Dem., 103,131; Langdon, Ind., 111,117. Gillett's plurality, 12,442.

RAILROADS RAISE OFFER

Announce Settlement of Dispute, but Switchmen Deny It.

CHICAGO, Nov. 8.—The switchmen today accepted the offer of the managers of the Western roads for an increase of 3 cents an hour in wages. A further increase of 3 cents an hour will be determined by arbitration.

The men at first demanded 5 cents increase an hour and an eight-hour day.

Late tonight it was stated that the announcement that the whole controversy had been amicably adjusted, as given out by the railroads this afternoon, was premature.

P. H. Morrissey, grand master of the Brotherhood of Railway Trainmen, current Governor Terrell was notified and declared that there was practically no change in the situation. Frank Hawley, of the Switchmen's Union, made the same statement, but admitted that he favored submitting the matter of a further increase to the Interstate Commerce Commission.

Raise \$1,000,000 for Extension.

SYRACUSE, N. Y., Nov. 8.—The Board of Church Extension of the Methodist Episcopal Church today decided to raise \$1,000,000 next year. Of this amount \$150,000 will be used for home mission work and \$850,000 for church extension.

Astoria Grocery Business Sold.
