The Southern Pacific Company has taken out a permit to erect a depot at the corner of East Morrison and East First streets, which is inside the limits. Now that the permit has been taken out the company cannot be prohibited from erecting the building. An effort will be made to induce the Southern Pacific to put up a stone or brick building instead of a frame structure.

ORDINANCE IS PREPARED

Measure Probably Will Be Passed by City Legislative Body—Exception Made in Favor of Southern Pacific. Fire limits for the East Side were mapped out yesterday by the special Council committee appointed for that purpose. The ordinance prepared by the committee, from the present outlook, is to be passed by the Council at its meeting Wednesday. A compromise was made yesterday with the Southern Pacific and E. M. Brannick and Whitney L. Boise, who have been leading the fight for the fire limits, agreed to the ordinance.

TIES WOMAN; ROBS HOUSE

Burglar, Finding Her Alone, Blinds the Lady, Hand and Foot. SAN FRANCISCO, Feb. 15.—Report was made to the police this morning by Mrs. Mildred Corseau that while she was alone in her house at 1532 Sanchez street yesterday a burglar in the guise of a peddler called at her house, and after ascertaining that she was alone seized, bound her hands and feet and tied her to a nail in a closet, where she remained until late in the afternoon, when her husband returned. The burglar secured \$12 and a small amount of jewelry.

LOSES HER DAMAGE SUIT

Miss Sheman Sued in Action Against Portland Railway. Injuries of such a nature as to give the impression she is addicted to drink were caused by a streetcar accident which befell Miss Emma Sheman last summer, according to her statement in the State Circuit court yesterday, during the trial of her suit against the Portland Railway Company. Judge Gantenbein granted a nonsuit when the case was ready for the jury. It was shown that Miss Sheman stepped from a car and was struck by a second car coming from another direction. By getting off in this way she was guilty of contributory negligence, so the court held. Inasmuch as there is a city ordinance which requires that passengers be prevented by a metal gate from alighting in this manner and the testimony showed that no such gate was in use at the time, Miss Sheman intends to take the suit up again and include this phase of the matter in her pleadings.

IDAHO PAYS DETECTIVES

DEFICIENCY APPROPRIATION GOES THROUGH THE HOUSE. Large Sums to Attorneys—Senate Passes Two County Division Bills. Optional License Favored. A detailed statement of the deficiency warrants on account of the prosecution of the case shows that the Pinkerton detective agency has been paid \$15,913.88 for services and expenses, and the Thiel agency has been paid \$209,275. The bill for attorneys and their expenses foots up to \$24,539.15. Of this sum \$5,940 was paid Mr. Borah and \$19,039.15 to Mr. Hawley, while W. A. Stone was paid \$500. The list as published does not show what portion of the legal expense was for fees and what for expenses. Local detectives and guards consume much of the remainder, while \$3000 is added for interest.
