

BUTTER DOWN

Heavy Supplies Cause Another Drop in Local Market.

PRICES WEAK AT CLOSE

All Grades of Sugar Advance 20 Cents Per Hundred—Flour Prices Will Be Higher Today.

The butter market is rapidly seeking its proper level. The city creameries put out quotations yesterday morning of 27 1/2 cents, which was a decline of 2 1/2 cents a pound for most of them and an advance of 2 1/2 cents for those which maintained the top figure at the opening of the week.

Stocks are rapidly accumulating all around and a further decline is inevitable. In some quarters it is thought that the market will drop to 20 cents, which was the bottom last year, before the decline is checked, but other authorities in the trade do not look for such extreme low prices.

SUGAR IS TWENTY CENTS HIGHER.

Local Market Promptly Follows Advance by Specie's Refinery.

Portland wholesale grocers put up their sugar prices 20 cents per hundred yesterday morning. This rise has been expected every day since the California & Hawaiian Company advanced its list this amount last week.
