CALVIN S. HEILIG RETURNS FROM THE SOUTH.

Syndicate of Los Angeles Capitalists Plan to Erect Playhouse Costing \$300,000.

Once again it is announced that Portland is to have a new \$300,000 theater within the next year.

The final details have not been arranged and the deal is not yet closed.

Mr. Heilig feels reasonably confident that the plan will be carried out. He declines to designate the site, but says several are under consideration.

He also brings word that the Northwestern Association has extended its operations to the City of the Angels and after September will operate an important theater in that city.
