Coquille People After Steamer Manzanita for Coast Run.

M. L. BINGHAM IN PORTLAND

Is Negotiating With Columbia Contract Company for the Purchase of the Vessel—Was Formerly in the Lighthouse Service.

M. L. Bingham, of Coquille, has returned to Portland and has renewed his endeavors to interest local merchants in the establishment of a steamship line between Portland and points on the Coquille.

Early in March Mr. Bingham arrived in Portland from Coquille River for the purpose of interesting local men in the Coast country. He was prepared at that time to put several thousand dollars in a steamship enterprise provided the balance could be obtained from the end.

The Manzanita would make a splendid vessel for the Coquille River run. She is a craft of 60 gross tons burden, is 122 feet long, 26 feet beam and 11 feet depth of hold.

KAN WILL FIGHT IN COURT

MERCHANT RESISTS ATTEMPT TO CANCEL LICENSE.

Attorney Moser Declares Ordinance Unconstitutional—Mayor Has Not Yet Signed Revocation.

The fight between the City Council and the license committee of the Council on one side, and Andrew Kan and his attorney, C. Moser, on the other, as to the right of the Japanese merchant to sell goods under the terms of a second-class auction license while possessing only a first-class license, is still on.

The ordinance revoking Mr. Kan's first-class auction license, which was passed at the last meeting of the Council, has not been signed by Mayor Lamb yet, said Attorney Moser last night.

"I further contend that the Council, under the ordinance, cannot refuse to issue a first-class license to whoever applies for a license of that kind. In the case of Mr. Kan, the license committee of the Council granted the license which he now has after we paid the required fee for six months.
