Every precaution is made to keep the ashes and dirt where they belong—rendered possible by the triple ash grates, the large ash pan and the airtight clean-out door. The extra large draft construction and fingered grate extending along the entire length of the firebox assure an even distribution of heat on the top of the range and around the oven, and give a complete and even combustion of fuel.
