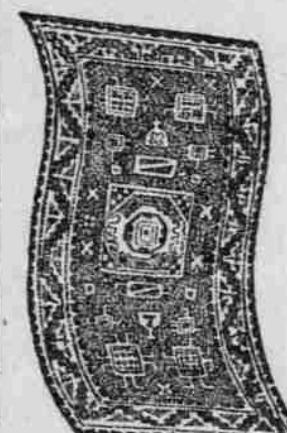

**THROAT CUT EAR TO EAR**

Body Found in Vacant Lot—Barber Suspected of Murder.

SAN FRANCISCO, Aug. 29.—Francis Rubio was found lying in a vacant lot on the south side of Jackson street this morning with his throat cut from ear to ear. Alfred Rocus, a friend of the murdered man, who is a barber, was seen with the dead man last night and has been placed under arrest on suspicion of having killed Rubio. A bloody razor was found in Rocus' pocket.

Philipino Wood for Lead Pencils.

WASHINGTON, Aug. 29.—It is learned from Manila that samples of Philippine woods believed to be available for making lead pencils have been sent to New York to be tested. Lead pencil woods have become so scarce that if the Philippine woods are satisfactory it will create a large market therefor. The samples shipped to New York are of red lauan and balatucan.

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Many Settlers Coming, Says President of Commercial Club.

C. W. Hodson, president of the Commercial Club, is enthusiastic in regard to the advantage Portland and all points in Oregon will receive in the increase in the number of homeseekers as a result of the colonial rates which will be in effect on September 1 and continue until October 31. In discussing this question Mr. Hodson said yesterday: "By 30 o'clock tomorrow morning the Portland Commercial Club will have delivered 25,000 of the \$0.09 leaflets advertising Portland and Oregon. Most of these will reach outside people through the enormous correspondence which goes out from the places of business on the first of the month, and all that is necessary to make the circulation of these leaflets of tremendous benefit to the state is for people in general to take an interest in distributing them. Of course advertising matter sent out by a Commercial Club does a great deal of good, but no one believes it is so effective as when that same advertising matter is accompanied by a personal letter."
