## ASK DEPOSITORS TO SIGN

MEETING WEDNESDAY NIGHT HAS DEFINITE OBJECT.

Leaders in Reorganization Scheme Urge That All Come to Help of Plan.

Depositors only are asked to attend the meeting of the Depositors' Association Wednesday night when the reorganization of the Oregon Trust & Savings Bank will be the all-absorbing topic. All who attend that have not signed up a portion of their balances for telephone bonds will be asked to subscribe before they leave the hall. A general discussion of the reorganization plan will be had. "A possible 40 cents in three years or a positive dollar before New Year's" will be the subject up for discussion. The meeting will be held in Arion hall, Second and Oak streets. Officers of the association who are working hardest for the reorganization plan desire that wom-

en depositors who do not understand the matter shall give their bank books to friends upon whose judgment they rely and advise with them as to how to proceed after the meeting.

The total subscriptions to telephone bonds and bank stock up to last night was \$370,000. Secretary Richmond said business was somewhat slow yesterday and that depositors will have to come in faster if they are to get their money back.

"Unless the subscriptions come in better within the time stipulated a few days ago, we will throw up the reorganization scheme and take what we can get from the receiver," said President J. L. Day of the association last night. "The chief regret I will have in such a case is that those who signed for bonds might not have gotten them so they could show within a short time the benefits of such a settlement. Interest paid by the bonds will in three years amount to 50 per cent of the total that may be expected to be paid by the receiver in small dividends in the same length of time or longer." "There are a great many interested who have not yet called and I would be glad if these people will either call at the headquarters over the bank or will attend the meeting so they can be informed on the benefits of the reorganization plan. I ask as a special favor that depositors who have not yet signed will not come to a positive conclusion until they have made

an investigation and that they do not be advised by anyone who is not familiar with the plan and the condition of the bank. People who advise their friends without investigating should consider carefully lest they work an injury to those who they seek to help by advising."

## TAFT WILL BE ON TIME

MINNESOTA MAKING QUICK TRIP IN ORIENT.

Will Reach Hongkong October 11, and Manila in Time to Open Congress.

SEATTLE, Wash., Oct. 7. (Special.)--Secretary of War William H. Taft, will reach Manila in plenty of time to preside over the first session of the Philippine Congress. By this time the steamship Minnesota should be nearly ready to leave Shanghai and the Oriental liner will arrive in Hong Kong on or before October 11, the date originally fixed for the War Secretary's arrival in that port. The Minnesota left Nagasaki for Shanghai at 6 o'clock Sunday morning with Secretary Taft aboard, according to cable advices to the Great Northern Steamship Company. The boat had been held a day in Kobe to allow the

## War Secretary that much extra time

in Japan, and but for that circumstance would have reached Shanghai practically on time. When the Minnesota left Seattle the boat was three days late and word had gone out that there was a strong probability Secretary Taft would have to postpone the opening of the Philippine Congress so he could be present. The initial session is set down for October 16 and it was figured the War Secretary would be unable to make up the time lost in port. But for the day lost in Kobe he would be on time now and before he reaches Hongkong all the lost time will have been made up.
