Deserve More Pay.

"The school teachers certainly deserve an increase," declared Frelschner yesterday. "I do not think that the request for 12 months' pay at the present rate is exorbitant, and I shall vote for it."

"My idea is to grant the higher salaries and if we have any teachers who are not worth so much to the district, we can let them go."

Whatever action is taken by the board will be only in the nature of a recommendation as the higher tax levy necessary would have to be voted at the meeting of the taxpayers in December.

Teachers' salaries in Portland are now lower than they were 15 years ago. The high salaries that were once paid were cut down during the hard times of the early 90's.
