Resigns Place on the State Sailor Commission.

TAKES EFFECT FEBRUARY 1

Gives as Reason a Press of Personal Business - Alfred Tucker, of Meyer Wilson, Probably Will Succeed Him - Marine News.

Captain Andrew Hobe has forwarded his resignation as a member of the State Sailor Boarding-House Commission to Governor Chamberlain with the request that it be accepted and the resignation take effect February 1.

The State Sailor Boarding-House Commission is the creation of the Legislature and has been in effect for several years. The bill was passed in the interest of shipping and provides for the maintenance of a board, and for the issuing of licenses for the conducting of sailor boarding-houses and fixes the rates which shall be paid by masters for sailors.

At present two licenses are out. The board issued one last week to the Jost Brothers. Heretofore the business has been satisfactorily conducted by White Brothers and Grant. Ships have not been held up and masters and owners were satisfied. The rate for men for the United Kingdom at the Cape is \$35 with \$39 advance.

SUCCESS TO HEART DISEASE

Henry Brook, a brick manufacturer, of Spokane, Wash., died of heart disease at 11:30 o'clock Thursday night on board the steamship Roanoke, while that vessel was bound down the river. The remains were taken ashore, at Astoria, and prepared for shipment to Spokane by a local undertaker.

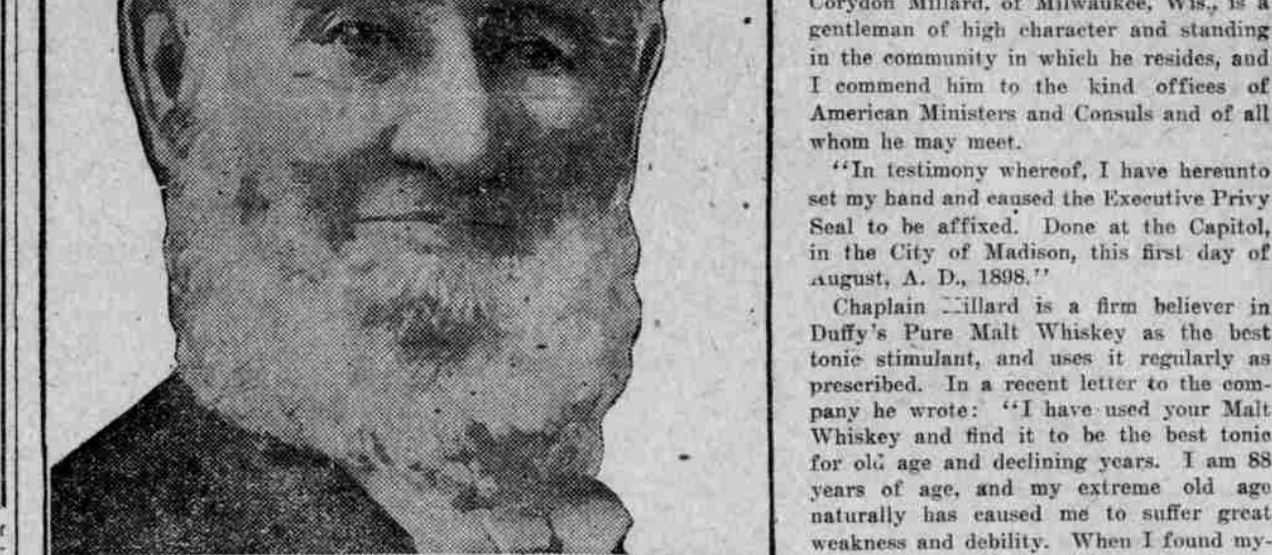
