

MASS TARIFF TICKET BEFORE PRIMARY

Republican Committee Proposes That Party Mass Meeting Be Held.

DEFERS ACTION ONE WEEK

Resolutions Also Introduced Criticizing Eight Ward Committeemen for Taking Stand Against the Candidacy of Gus C. Moser.

Resolutions providing a plan whereby a County Republican ticket should be recommended at a mass meeting composed of delegates from precinct clubs throughout the city were introduced last night at the meeting of the City and County Republican central committee held in Aliskey hall.

The resolutions were introduced by an animated discussion, but final action was postponed to another meeting called for one week from tonight.

The resolutions were introduced on the merits of the program outlined by the resolutions, some fearing it would be construed by the public as an attempt to evade the direct primary law, while others were just as positive that the scheme was in accord both with the letter and spirit of that legislation.

A lively discussion came up at the meeting following the introduction of resolutions disapproving of the action of the committeemen from the Eighth ward in going on record against the candidacy of Gus C. Moser for District Attorney, and taking a stand against any similar action by committee members toward candidates for any office.

The resolution favoring the endorsement of Republican candidates before the primaries were introduced by A. B. Manley in a speech strongly urging its adoption. The resolution follows:

Propose Precinct Clubs. Whereas, it is made the duty of the Central Committee by the general election law of this state to provide rules and regulations for the conduct of the Republican party; therefore, be it

Resolved, That the Republicans of the several precincts in the County of Oregon, be, and they hereby are requested, to form a precinct club in each precinct and elect two delegates from each club to the City of Portland at a time to be appointed by the central committee, to select, recommend or endorse candidates to be nominated at the coming primary election in their respective precincts, to be filled at the next general election.

The introduction of these resolutions was in accord with the purpose of the meeting, the call for which instructed the committeemen to gather information, as to the desire of the voters of the several precincts to meet in mass convention, and to report thereon to the central committee.

Some members asserting that their constituents were wedded to the direct primary law and would consider nothing infringing on their rights, while others, however, believed that the plan would be welcomed, but emphasized the necessity of making the proposed mass meeting representative of the party.

Multnomah County as a whole and not of any faction.

"It is not for this committee to organize precinct clubs for the purpose of nominating delegates to a nominating convention," declared W. M. Davis, who led the opposition against the plan.

"It would simmer down to the various committeemen called together to select the men they knew wanted the men the committeemen favored. Then they would select two delegates to the convention with everything else dried in advance."

It is nothing less than getting back to the old convention, only it would be worse.

"Do you think the party at large would stand for any such plan that they have then knifed to name a slate? It would be the best nomination a man could have to say the convention had turned him down. Then he would come out as an independent, and that is the best 'knifing' than there has been in the past."

Other members of the committee took the same position as that expressed by Davis, and they regretted the enactment of the direct primary law, and believed it was working thoroughly to disorganize the party.

The party, they believed, would be able to be on the books, and predicted disaster for the party if a mass meeting were called to name a ticket.

Perfect Party Organization. "There is no purpose of evading the primary law in calling this meeting," asserted Mr. Manley in support of his resolutions. "The law provides that the central committee shall provide means to perfect party organization. The resolution simply means that a ticket be named which is representative of the will of the party as a whole. Organization is the only way to success, and if the Republicans do not vote together, we cannot have Democratic office-holders just as we now have."

"The Democrats nominated a complete ticket before the primary two years ago," declared one member. "If organization is good for the Democrats it is good for the Republicans."

Chairman Manley explained the scheme for nominating a ticket at a mass meeting, as proposed. He said it was not intended to have the central committee dominate the convention, but make it representative of the Republican voters at large.

The intention is that the members of this committee shall work to organize Republican clubs in their own precincts. When these clubs are in existence the duty of the committeemen in the matter ends. Then the clubs themselves will take charge and elect delegates to the meeting that shall name a ticket. The voters will therefore name the ticket themselves and they will be less 'knifed' if a ticket named in a meeting than if a dozen candidates go before the primaries for the same office."

In view of the importance of the matter, the motion to postpone it until Tuesday carried unanimously. At that time it is hoped to have every member in attendance. In the meantime a committee of seven, yet to be appointed by Chairman Manley, will consider the resolutions offered by Mr. Manley.

The resolutions, criticizing the Eighth Ward Republicans for going on record against the candidacy of Mr. Moser were introduced by Mr. Davis and created a stir among the members. They involve the important issue as to whether the candidacy of any man is to be supported or handicapped by the endorsement or censure of any portion of the central committee. A committee of five will also be appointed to consider them and seek to reach an agreement satisfactory to all.

Davis Defends Moser. "The members from the Eighth Ward have done Mr. Moser a great injustice,"

declared Mr. Davis in introducing his resolutions. "Certainly no member of this committee should take any such action if we are even in doubt as to whether the party as a whole should endorse candidates."

"If you are going to censure the members from the Eighth Ward by passing these resolutions, it is no way to promote party harmony," replied one of their number. "The people of our district do not want to accept anyone as a candidate who has held office under a Democrat. Mr. Moser's own statement announcing his candidacy in which he had said Mr. Manning would support him, looked like some kind of a deal had been made between them and we do not want to stand for any compromise with Democrats. Let Mr. Moser challenge Mr. Manning to take the field against him instead of accepting Mr. Manning's support."

"That is just what I did in my statement," responded Mr. Moser, who denied that there was any alliance between him and Mr. Manning.

Mr. Moser then went over his record to show that he had been faithful to the Republican party, and after a short discussion it was decided to take up the matter again at the next meeting.

HONOR MEMORY OF BURNS

Clan Macleay Meets on Anniversary of Scottish Bard's Birthday.

charges made by Noland, and the latter seriously believed his daughter was lured to ruin by Conboy, that Noland would not have allowed Conboy in the restaurant, and that he had been in the restaurant when the incident occurred.

Councilman Vaughn and those opposed to Conboy will undoubtedly argue that the turkey dinner incident is unworthy of serious consideration.

Noland Tells of Daughter's Fall. Noland took the stand and swore that the Conboy saloon has always been a respectable place, that young girls have been seen to enter there frequently and that he has seen them coming from the saloon intoxicated. He swore that Conboy entered into an agreement to receive and deliver letters between Breckenridge and Miss Noland, and that Conboy assisted the pair in their movements, unknown to Noland. The boy eventually eloped with the girl, they go to Tacoma, they were returned by Detective Hawley. The boy was sent to the Reform School and the girl to the House of the Good Shepherd. It was charged by Noland that the liquor drunk by the pair was purchased from Conboy's saloon. The father denied that his daughter ever frequented the saloon.

Fama and Maude Wilkinson, aged 17 and 15 years, respectively, living at 11 North Twenty-first street, and employed as waitresses in Noland's restaurant, swore that Conboy had invited them to come to his saloon by the back door, and said no one would see them; that he said he would be glad to have them visit him and would see that no one found it out. They refused his invitations, they swore, and he ceased to patronize Noland's restaurant. This fact caused an inquiry that led to the discovery of the secret of his absence from the tables. Both young women came to Portland from a rural district but one year ago, they said, and had never seen the inside of a saloon.

Heard Conboy Use "Love Language" V. J. Porter, living at Noland's hotel, swore that he had seen women in Conboy's saloon, in a back room, on a dozen occasions, but he thought that, if it is the custom for women to be allowed in saloons, that Conboy's saloon was all right; that its reputation was good. He had heard Conboy use some "love language" over the telephone one night, but regarded the words as proper enough, under the circumstances, and said it was probably all right.

During the progress of the case, Conboy demanded the privilege of interrogating some witnesses, although his own attorney had been present. Conboy denies every allegation made against him, and says he will dispose every accusation in due time. He will make a fight for further time in which to prepare his defense, and it would not be surprising if the case is not completed this afternoon.

For the accommodation of the police, the committee took the testimony of J. W. Robertson, who charges that L. was robbed of \$19 in Fallon's saloon some time ago. He said that Fallon and the bartender knew of and condoned the affair and refused to assist him.

A committee from a newly-formed organization known as the Retail Liquor Dealers' Mutual, Social and Protective Association, appeared before the liquor-license committee and expressed a desire to assist in clearing out all bar saloons and in helping the committee in any feasible manner.
