

SENATE PASSES CURRENCY BILL

Bourne, Borah and Heyburn Vote With Democrats Against It.

IMPORTANT CHANGES MADE

Provision Against Hoarding Money in Reserve Cities and Against Bank Officers' Loans to Themselves—House Doubtful.

WASHINGTON, March 27.—The Aldrich bill was passed by the Senate today by a vote of 42 to 16, in the main a party vote. Previous to the taking of the vote on the Aldrich bill, a vote was taken on the Bailey substitute authorizing the Government, instead of the National banks, to issue the emergency circulation for which the bill provides.
