Clatsop Calls in Its Warrants.

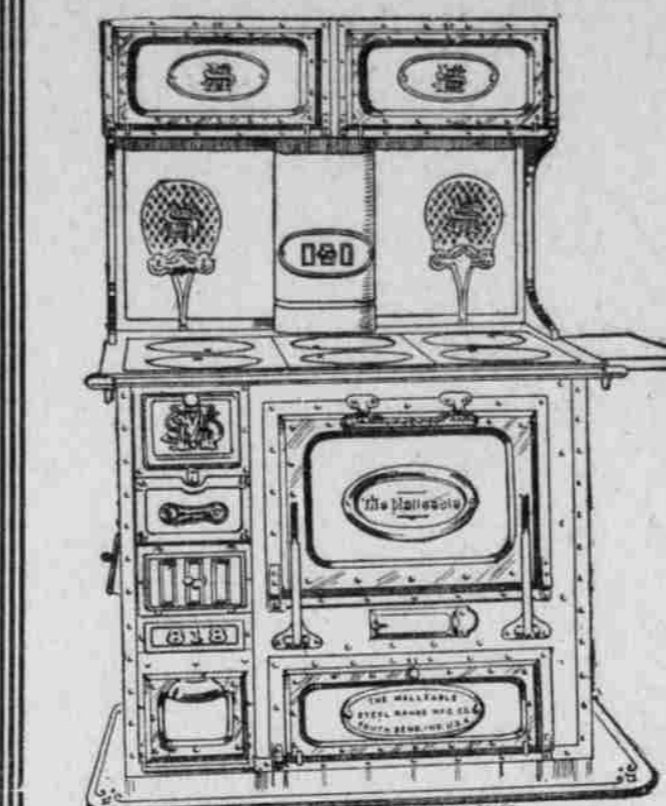
