

TOURIST SHOT IN TURKEY
Banker Accidentally Killed by Syrian on Train.

WASHINGTON, April 3.—The State Department today received a dispatch from Ambassador Leishman at Constantinople reporting the death of an American citizen, supposed to be a Syrian while on the train traveling from Damascus. The Syrian was arrested and explained that the shooting was purely accidental. The American and the Syrian were in adjoining compartments on the train.

NEWTON, Kan., April 3.—The man killed at Constantinople is R. Workentin, a pioneer business man of Newton, now on a trip abroad accompanied by his wife, according to a cablegram received here. Workentin was president of the Kansas State Bank of Newton.
