

HEARING ON RATES IS SET

O. R. & N. CASE IN FEDERAL COURT ON JULY 6.

Fishing Trips Make It Difficult for Court and Counsel to Agree on Date.

Because the judge and both opposing lawyers wanted to go fishing, there was some trouble in fixing the date for the hearing of a railroad case in the Federal Court yesterday.

"The reason Mr. Teal wants this case postponed is so that he can go fishing," declared Mr. Cotton. "He knows very well that he intends going on a fishing trip next week and that is the only reason he wants the hearing deferred."
